

## **RE: CHANGES TO TRANSCRIPT FEE RATES**

The Judicial Conference of the United States approved adjustments to the maximum per page original and copy transcript fee rates. The following transcript fee rates are effective October 1, 2023.

<b>30-Days (Ordinary)</b> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of the deposit.	\$4.00	\$1.00	\$0.70
<b>14-Days</b> A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of the deposit.	\$4.70	\$1.00	\$0.70
<b>7-Days (Expedited)</b> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of the deposit.	\$5.35	\$1.00	\$0.70
<b>3-Days</b> A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of the deposit.	\$6.00	\$1.20	\$0.85
<b>Next-Day (Daily)</b> A transcript to be delivered within 24 hours after receipt of the deposit.	\$6.70	\$1.35	\$1.00

<b>Realtime Transcript</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.	One feed, \$3.40 per page, two-to-four feeds, \$2.35 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.65 per page. Orders placed on or before the day of the proceeding will be batched together for purpose of determining the number of feeds; and subsequent orders will be charged at the lowest page rate assessed on the previous orders.
